

# CALL FOR NOMINATIONS TO THE ENHR COORDINATION COMMITTEE

The Election Committee and the Secretariat of the ENHR are pleased to issue a Call for Nominations to the ENHR Coordination Committee. New members of the Coordination Committee will be elected during the General Assembly at the conference in Istanbul, Turkey in July 2010. If you are member of the Network and wish to nominate someone, or wish to be nominated yourself, please complete the following form and include a biographical sketch of about 200 words of the person being nominated.

According to the ENHR Charter, there should be between 13 and 15 members on the Coordination Committee. The term of office for Lars Gulbrandsen, Claire Levy-Vroelant, Iván Tosics, and Christian Tutin expires in 2010. They may stand for re-election. Another member, Christine Whitehead, has announced that she will step down on that occasion. The ENHR Coordination Committee has announced that six seats will be up for election in 2010. The candidates who are nominated to be elected in 2010 will be presented on the ENHR website at an early date and postal ballots may be submitted before the General Assembly.

The following nine members were elected in Dublin to serve until the General Assembly in 2012: Peter Boelhouwer, Lena Magnusson, David Mullins, Montserrat Pareja, Richard Sendi, Mark Stephens, Hedvig Vestergaard, Sule Özuekren (and Christine Whitehead).

There are a number of important things to consider when nominating a candidate to the Coordination Committee. First of all, it is important to have as many people as possible nominated to ensure a fair and representative election. You are therefore urged to consider standing for the Committee or to nominate another ENHR member! Secondly, it is important to remember that members of the Coordination Committee are expected to attend, at their own expense, a number of meetings during the year and to be active at ENHR conferences. Finally, the General Assembly of the Network has emphasised the importance of a balanced composition of the Coordination Committee. The profile of the present Committee is summarised below:

When composing the sketch, consider mentioning the candidate's academic position, their activities in the Network, a maximum of three key publications, and issues that he or she feels are important for the future of the Network. Examples of biographical sketches can be found in Newsletter 2/2008 where the candidates in that year's election were presented.

The names and presentations of the candidates will be publicised in various ways: on the ENHR website; in the June 2010 issue of the Newsletter; and separate sheet will be available at the General Assembly in Istanbul. When the time comes, ballots will be available on the website, in the Newsletter, and at the General Assembly.
